



## Quarterly Programming Reports

Every three months, each broadcast radio and television station licensee must prepare and place in its station public file a list of programs containing its most significant treatment of community issues during the preceding three months (“issues/programs lists”). The list must briefly describe both the issue and the programming during which the issue was discussed, including the date and time that each such program was aired and its title and duration. The licensee must keep these lists in the file until the next grant of the station renewal application has become final.

Each year commercial and non-commercial radio station Quarterly Lists must be placed in your public inspection file by

- January 10 (reflecting October, November, December)
- April 10 (reflecting January, February, March)
- July 10 (reflecting April, May, June)
- October 10 (reflecting July, August, September)

LPFM stations are not required to retain/file Issues and Programming Lists.
